We gratefully appreciate anything you can do for the club, and our yearly charitable cause. With all of us working together, it will, as always, be a great success!

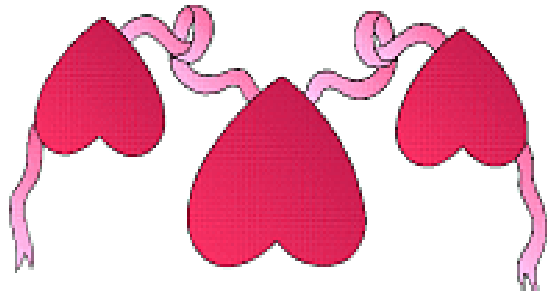
