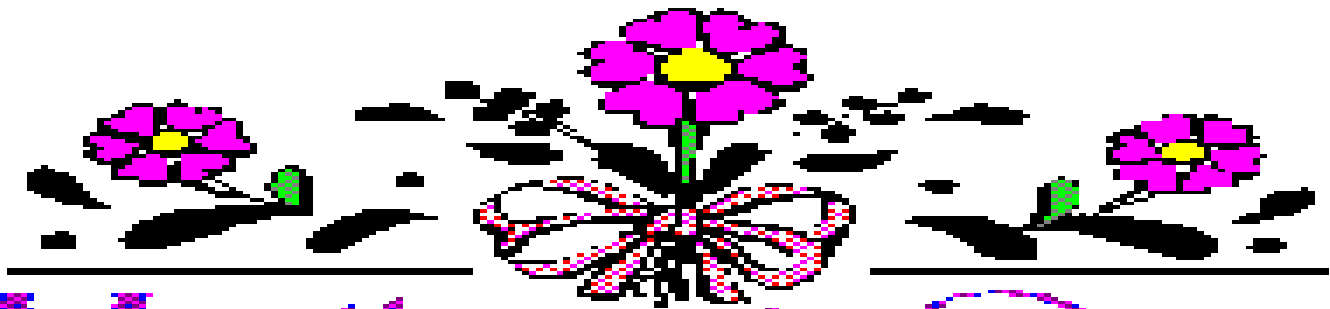

I really want to extend a special thank-you to Ron French for collecting many door prizes. We will have a tally for the prizes in the next newsletter. Thank you for all your efforts!

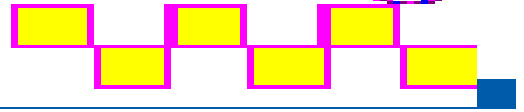
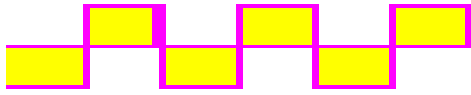
